

Design a Road Safety Sign


Grab the colouring in pencils and design your own road safety sign to encourage people to drive safely.

Quiz Board Game

Instructions:

2-4 players, suitable for children 4+.

The aim of the game is to get from 70 miles per hour to 0 miles per hour before you reach the end of the road. The first one who gets to 0mph wins. An adult can help you to cut out your board, cars, speedometers, and question cards. Then you can start playing!

How to play:

Take turns rolling the dice and picking a question from the pack.

If you get the question right, slow down 10 miles per hour and stay where you are on the board. You can use your speedometer to keep track of what speed you're on.

If you get the question wrong, move forward as many spaces as you roll on the dice.

Play until someone wins by reaching 0 miles per hour first or being the only one not to reach the end of the road.




